PhilSci-Archive is an online archive for preprints in the philosophy of science, where a preprint is an early, but complete, version of a new research paper. PhilSci-Archive invites submissions in all areas of philosophy of science, including general philosophy of science, philosophy of particular sciences (physics, biology, chemistry, psychology, etc.), feminist philosophy of science, socially relevant philosophy of science, history and philosophy of science and history of the philosophy of science.

PhilSci-Archive is a free service created in 2001 as an online means of circulating new work in philosophy of science. Preprints are accessible immediately and for free to all philosophers of science with internet access and at no cost to the author, whose priority is publicly authenticated by the date of posting. PhilSci-Archive is also used to speed the dissemination of a paper that has been accepted by a journal or volume but is not yet published. Nearly all philosophy of science journals encourage this practice.

The "Conferences and Volumes" section of PhilSci-Archive provides those organizing conferences or preparing volumes an easy way to circulate and collect advance copies of papers in one central location.
